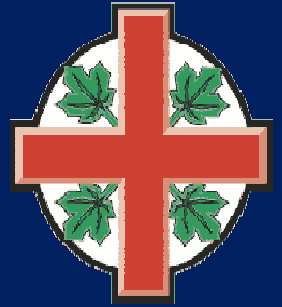

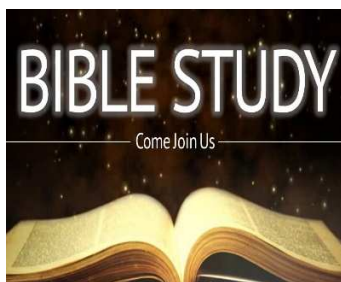

### **Friday Bible Study & Soup Supper**

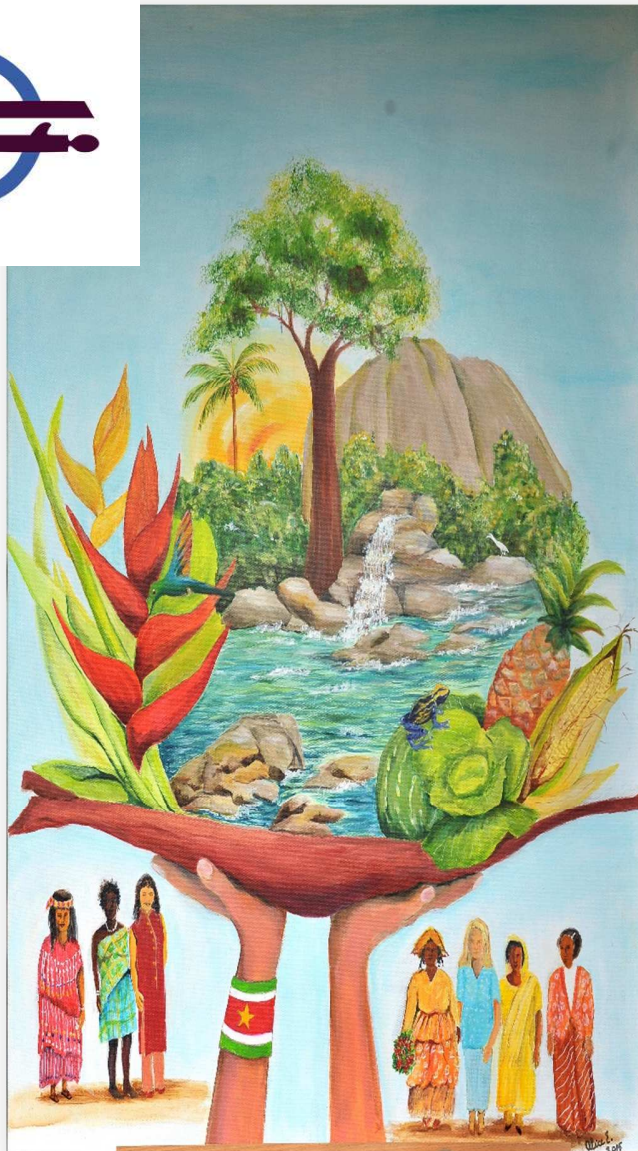
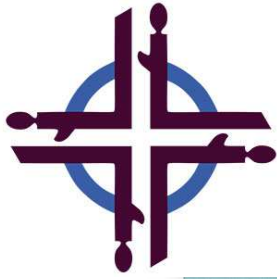
Friday Bible studies continues at 4:00 pm at the home of Rob & Susan Brockley - 465 Bruce Lynn Dr.

This year, the service is written by the **World Day of Prayer Committee of Suriname, which is located on the northeastern coast of South America.**

The service was prepared and adapted for use in Canada by the Women's Inter-Church Council of Women.

The World Day of Prayer is a global ecumenical movement which brings Christians of many traditions together to observe a common day of prayer each year. Through preparation and participation in the worship service, we can learn how our sisters of other countries, languages and cultures understand the Biblical passages in their context. In this way, it is possible to enrich our Christian faith as it grows deeper and broader in an international, ecumenical expression.

## George Matheson

---



One of his hymns, "**O Love That Wilt Not Let Me Go**," we are singing in church this Sunday. Matheson himself wrote of the composition:

*"I am quite sure that the whole work was completed in five minutes, and equally sure that it never received at my hands any retouching or correction. I have no natural gift of rhythm. All the other verses I have ever written are manufactured articles; this came like a dayspring from on high."* [3]

"O Love That Wilt Not Let Me Go" was written on the evening of Matheson's sister's marriage. Years before, he had been engaged, until his fiancée learned that he was going blind—that there was nothing the doctors could do—and she told him that she could not go through life with a blind man. He went blind while studying for the ministry, and his sister had been the one to care for him through the years, but now she was gone. He was now 40, and his sister's marriage brought a fresh reminder of his own heartbreak. It was in the midst of this circumstance and intense sadness that the Lord gave Matheson this hymn, which he said

was written in five minutes.

"Oh love that will not let me go, I rest my weary soul in thee; I give thee back the life I own, That in thine ocean depths its flow May richer, fuller be....."
